CONSULTANCY SERVICES TO UPGRADE THE UGANDA WILDLIFE AUTHORITY- ONLINE WILDLIFE DATABASE

Wildlife Conservation Society (WCS) is currently implementing a five- year USAID funded project titled “USAID/Uganda Combating Wildlife Crime Activity (CWC)”. The overall goal of the Activity is to reduce wildlife crime in Uganda by improving interagency coordination and collaboration; strengthening institutional wildlife crime law enforcement capacity; and improving data management systems and utilisation of high-quality data to inform anti-wildlife crime approaches. WCS is seeking for proposals from qualified digital database consultants to provide services for the upgrade or redevelopment of the Online Wildlife Database (OWODAT) managed by Uganda Wildlife Authority (UWA).

Scope of Work

The consultant will work closely with UWA and WCS and is required to redevelop the database application and migrate it to a more robust and latest technology stack. The consultant is expected to deliver a user friendly, easier to maintain and fully functional Online Wildlife Database with an offline version
